

Village of Shorewood Hills

Caucus Minutes

Monday, January 22, 2007 - 7:00 pm

1. Village President Peter Hans called the caucus for the Village of Shorewood Hills to order at 7:05 pm. He announced that the caucus was being held to determine the Village candidates for the Spring Election on April 3, 2007. Mr. Hans requested that all present sign the attendance roster, indicating their names and addresses.
2. Mr. Hans opened nominations for the election of two tellers to canvass the vote in the event that it was necessary. Marilyn Townsend, 1121 Wellesley Road, nominated Charlotte Stein, 2805 Columbia Road; her nomination was seconded by Jane Pizer, 3539 Topping Road. Marilyn Vanderhoof Young, 2801 Colgate Road, nominated Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road; his nomination was seconded by Hannah Pinkerton, 2901 Colgate Road. Mr. Hans called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were none. By a voice vote of those in attendance Ms. Stein and Mr. Young were elected unanimously.
3. Mr. Hans announced that the position of Municipal Judge was vacant. He opened nominations for Municipal Judge. He asked each resident to give his or her name and address when making a nomination. Pat Remington, 1214 Dartmouth Road, nominated Frank Remington, 2902 Columbia Road, for Municipal Judge. Mr. Remington's nomination was seconded by Gard Strother, 1101 Oak Way. Mr. Hans called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were no more nominations; no run off election was necessary.
4. Mr. Hans announced that he, the incumbent Village President, would not be seeking reelection. Mr. Hans opened nominations for Village President. He asked each resident to give his or her name and address when making a nomination. Dave Benforado, 3902 University Avenue, nominated Mark Sundquist, 3215 Tally Ho Lane; the nomination was seconded by Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road. Jane Pizer, 3539 Topping Road nominated Joyce Bromley, 3535 Topping Road; the nomination was seconded by Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road. Mr. Hans called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were none. Since only two candidates were nominated for Village President there was no need for a run off election.
5. Mr. Hans announced the names of the three incumbent Village Trustees whose terms will expire in April, 2007: Lori DiPrete Brown, Mark Sundquist and a vacancy. Mr. Hans opened nominations for the three Village Trustee positions. He asked each resident to give his or her name and address when making a nomination. Claudia Werner 3523 Blackhawk Drive, nominated Bob Hurley, 3448 Crestwood Drive; the nomination was seconded by Charlie Field, 3421 Blackhawk Drive. Tom Larson, 3605 Sunset Drive, nominated Tim Ridders, 3510 Sunset Drive; the nomination was seconded by Gard Strother, 1101 Oak Way. Lori DiPrete Brown nominated Felice Borisy Rudin, 3219 Topping Road; her nomination was seconded by Jill Dittrich, 1115 Oak Way. Mr. Hans

called three times “Are there any more nominations?” There were none. Since fewer than six candidates were nominated for Village Trustee there was no need for a run off election.

6. Mr. Hans gave each candidate, in the order nominated, an opportunity to give a short speech. Afterward Mr. Hans asked each candidate to see the Village Clerk before leaving to receive the necessary candidate paperwork.
7. Mr. Hans closed the caucus at 7:28 pm.
