

Village of Shorewood Hills
Caucus Minutes
Monday, January 22, 2008 7:00 pm

1. Village President Mark Sundquist called the Caucus for the Village of Shorewood Hills to order at 7:01 p.m. He announced that the Caucus was being held to determine the Village candidates for the Spring Election on April 4, 2008. Mr. Sundquist requested that the approximately 50 attendees sign the attendance roster, indicating their names and addresses.
2. Mr. Sundquist opened nominations for the election of two tellers to canvass the vote in the event that it was necessary. Marilyn Townsend, 1121 Wellesley Road, nominated Ellie Munson, 3610 Lake Mendota Drive; her nomination was seconded by Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road. Marilyn Vanderhoof Young, 2801 Colgate Road, nominated Adrienne Gross, 3308 Tally Ho Lane; her nomination was seconded by Joyce Bromley, 3535 Topping Road. Mr. Sundquist called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were none. By a voice vote of those in attendance Ms. Munson and Ms. Gross were elected unanimously.
3. Mr. Sundquist announced that the term of the incumbent Municipal Judge, Frank Remington, would expire in April, 2008. He opened nominations for Municipal Judge. He asked each resident to give his or her name and address when making a nomination. Debby Remington, 2902 Columbia Road, nominated Frank Remington, 2902 Columbia Road, for Municipal Judge. Mr. Remington's nomination was seconded by Marilyn Vanderhoof Young, 2801 Colgate Road. Mr. Sundquist called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were no more nominations; no run off election was necessary.
4. Mr. Sundquist announced the names of the three incumbent Village Trustees whose terms will expire in April, 2008: David Benforado, Joyce Bromley and Marilyn Townsend. Mr. Sundquist opened nominations for the three Village Trustee positions. He asked each resident to give his or her name and address when making a nomination. Sam Braithwait, 3424 Viburnum, nominated Marilyn Townsend, 1121 Wellesley Road; the nomination was seconded by Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road. Jim Hodder, 3441 Crestwood, nominated Joyce Bromley, 3535 Topping Road; the nomination was seconded by Robert Woodson, 3530 Topping Road. Tom Young, 2801 Colgate Road, nominated David Benforado, 3902 University Avenue; his nomination was seconded by Sam Braithwait, 3424 Viburnum. Mr. Sundquist called three times "Are there any more nominations?" There were none. Since fewer than six candidates were nominated for Village Trustee there was no need for a run off election
6. Mr. Sundquist gave each candidate, in the order nominated, an opportunity to give a short speech. Afterward Mr. Sundquist asked each candidate to see the Village Clerk before leaving to receive the necessary candidate paperwork.
7. Mr. Sundquist closed the Caucus at 7:22 p.m.
