 - a. Petar Igetic: A reminder that Sumac Road needs attention to make the street safe for children.
 - b. Laurel Cavalluzzo: Requests consideration for Highbury Road to be converted to a one-way street, northbound. Drivers going east on Topping Road continue to turn onto Highbury Road (illegally) and other drivers traveling east on Topping Road make a U-turn at the Topping Road and Oak Way in order to drive down Highbury Road. She reported that the green arrow operates with a trigger for traffic traveling into Shorewood Commons and the trigger requires cars to be forward in that intersection which is in the path of pedestrians.
 - c. Clare Campbell: Requests 2 speed bumps to be installed on both Columbia Road and Swarthmore Court. In the past, Columbia Road has had only one speed bump and it is less effective than the 2 bumps on Swarthmore Court.
 - d. Mariana Weinhold: Consider making Columbia Road along the school a one-way street.
