

# VILLAGE TREE SALE

ORDERS DUE BY – **March 31, 2008**

## LARGE TREES

1. **Shagbark Hickory (\$131.88 per 1.25” caliper tree):** A great native tree with good wildlife value and beautiful “shaggy”, exfoliating bark as the tree ages.
2. **Tuliptree (\$116.05 per 1.5” caliper tree):** Tulip shaped leaves turn yellow in the fall and has pale yellow tulip shaped flowers in the spring. 80’ tall x 40’ wide.
3. **Quaking Aspen (\$52.75 per 1” caliper tree):** Fast growing tree. Leaves tremble in a light breeze and turn golden-yellow in the fall. 40’ tall x 25’ wide.
4. **River Birch (\$68.58 per 6’ tall tree):** Native birch with attractive exfoliating bark. Tolerates a wide range of soil moisture conditions. 40’ tall x 30’ wide.
5. **Red Oak (\$123.44 per 1.5” caliper tree):** A faster growing native oak that prefers slightly acidic soil. Susceptible to oak wilt.

## SMALL TREES

6. **Ironwood (\$105.50 per 1.5” caliper tree):** Slow growing native tree that can tolerate shade. A good source of winter food for wildlife.
7. **Musclewood (\$132.93 per 1.5” caliper tree):** Smooth muscle-like bark. Another slow growing native that can tolerate shade. 20’ tall by 15’ wide.
8. **Adams Flowering Crab (\$75.96 per 1.5” caliper tree):** Splendid pink flowers and attractive red berries. Resistant to pest/diseases. 25’ tall.
9. **Ivory Silk Japanese Tree Lilac (\$113.94 per 1.5” caliper):** Large clusters of creamy white flowers in early summer. Pest resistant.

## EVERGREENS

10. **White Pine (\$89.68 per 48” tree):** Fast growing, shade tolerant, 50-80’ tall.
11. **Black Hills Spruce (\$89.68 per 48” tree):** Dense blue-green, disease resistant, 40’.
12. **Iowa Juniper (\$54.86 per 48” tree):** Nice berries, blue-green needles, 15’ tall x 8’.
13. **Arborvitae (\$65.41 per 5’ tree):** Good screen, full sun to part shade, 15-18’ tall.
14. **White Fir (\$96.01 per 48” tree):** Blue-green needles, disease resistant. 40-60’.
