

**Village of Shorewood Hills  
Public Works Committee Minutes  
1/28/13**

Jim made a motion to begin meeting, Mary second.

The group discussed the ditch cleanout project and associated improvements.

The items discussed are as follows:

1.a. pavers for plazas/path: the group preferred stamped colored concrete similar to pavers at existing entrance to pool. It was believed the concrete would hold up longer than pavers.

1.b. Benches, the group preferred the Waldorf bench

1.c. Tables, the group instructed Vierbicher to ask Thomas Steele to match the Waldorf bench with the tables

1.d. Trash cans, the group preferred the Gramercy model, with tops. Include recycling receptacle with blue lid and recycling sticker.

1.e. The plant palette was discussed. Corey suggested to replace paper birch with river birch

1.f. Light fixtures, the group preferred the pedestrian scale light as previously used on the Shorewood Blvd project. The stretch to be lit is from Shorewood Blvd. to Marshall Court along the bike paths and sidewalk. The consultant will explore trying to add 2 lights along the sidewalk from Columbia to Swarthmore. We may be able to have the shroud removed and engineer a 1' wide base.

1.g. Signage. Include 2 new park signs. This was later changed in item 4.

2. Entrance Plaza - Remove the western one. Maybe replace with bike racks. Western plaza may be moved so path does not extend through it.

3. Separation between path and park. Plan is acceptable in this regard.

4. Location for east park sign. The group preferred removing the east sign.

5. Fencing - Ok as shown

6. Physical barrier to prevent cyclists from using northern path? No. No bollards on either end.

7. Pergola. Remove pergola from design. Maybe add one pergola type wall between path and volleyball court to prevent ball from going on path.

8. Boardwalk. Include boardwalk as bid alternate. May not be necessary but worth investigating price in bid.

9. Sidewalk path material - stamped concrete. include more benches near tennis area.

10. Pool expansion area - Pool committee needs to work on it more. This decision should not hold up ditch or path project. Could happen later.

Jim made a motion to approve plan as shown with recommendations provided throughout the meeting. Chris seconds.
