

**Village of Shorewood Hills
Blackhawk Country Club Liaison Committee Minutes
Tuesday, July 12, 2022**

1. Administrative Procedures

- a. **Call to Order** – Shabnam Lotfi called the meeting to order at 5:31 pm.
- b. **Roll Call** – Shabnam Lotfi, Linda Bochert, Karen Rebholz, Steve Nakada, and Gary Johnson. Also present was Teresa Brommer, Administrative Assistant.
- c. **Statement of Public Notice and Note Compliance with Open Meeting Law** – Teresa Brommer confirmed the meeting had been properly noticed.

2. 4th July Music and Fireworks 2022 Update

- a. Linda Bochert reported 19 members of the **Echoes of Camp Randall** (UW Band) played to a small crowd from 8:30 – 8:50 pm. Blackhawk Country Club paid fee of \$865 with the Scramble Fund reimbursing the club leaving \$6737.10 in the fund. Suggested to book the band every year.
- b. Gary Johnson reported on the **4th of July Fireworks** noting all went well however, due to weather not all shells were shot off and some were sent back to Green Bay. Mr. Johnson stated that there was no plan B if fireworks show didn't go as planned for the 4th. Mentioned possible rain date for the 5th. Derek Schnarr (Director of Golf Operations) and Chad Grimm (Grounds Chief) would make happen. Brought up issues of association members getting older, not always available, need additional members, and the shell storage trucks are returned on the 5th causing an issue of storage if fireworks not on the 4th. Mr. Johnson, at time of meeting, has no financial total for the fireworks, believes they broke even but stated will have information next week.
- c. Karen Rebholz inquired if others outside the fireworks association and fire department could participate, maybe students or alumni of the Rocket Club. It was noted that the volunteer would have to be 18 or older. Karen Rebholz said she would send out emails for volunteers.

3. Potential Future joint events

- a. Linda Bochert suggested an “Evening on the Patio” making residents feel welcome to come to the Blackhawk Country Club. The event would be a friend raiser not a fund raiser. Noted people feel they must play golf to come to the club.
- b. Steve Nakada agreed with a casual event on patio with food and drinks.
- c. Shabnam Lotfi also agreed to the casual event noting that she grilled at the Shorewood Hills 4th of July event and was pleasantly surprised when the expected 100 residents turned out to be 500.
- d. Committee agreed the event should be in September, invitations need to be sent and information needs to be in the August bulletin. No date set in September.
