

**Village of Shorewood Hills
Draft Recreation Committee Minutes
Monday, August 8, 2022**

1. Administrative procedures

- a. **Call to Order** – Dietmar Bassuner called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.
- b. **Roll Call** – Mr. Bassuner, Andy Curtis, Santhia Brandt, Kat Hurley, Ty Cashen and Joel Fields were present. Peter Wickman was excused (Santhia Brandt noted that she did speak to Peter Wickman). Also present was Teresa Brommer, Administrative Services.
- c. **Statement of Public Notice and note compliance with open meeting law** – Ms. Brommer confirmed that the meeting had been properly posted.
- d. Approve previous meeting minutes – Ms. Brandt moved, and Mr. Curtis seconded a motion to approve the June 13, 2022, meeting minutes.
Vote: 5-0-1 (approved, Mr. Cashen abstaining since he did not attend that meeting).

2. Current state and status updates

- a. **Heiden Haus** – Mr. Bassuner stated 08/15/22 event cancelled at the last minute. Thanked Kat Hurley for coordinating food and ice cream truck.
- b. **Heiden Haus, Bocce 2023** – Mr. Bassuner stated there is a tentative date of 06/03/2023 (Saturday) for event with hope of no rain.
- c. **Heiden Haus, Summer Events 2023** – Mr. Bassuner requested the committee collectively come up with ideas for community events from May to when activity slows in August. Goal is to have a list of events by March/April 2023. Possible food trucks weekly/biweekly with live music to encourage the community to gather. Mr. Bassuner gathered ideas/suggestions as he went around the (virtual) room. Mr. Curtis applauded the continuation of the Bocce events. Ms. Hurley suggested calendarizing the food cart events co-mingling them with Bingo, DJs or Dance Parties. Mr. Cohen agreed that the food truck is a wonderful idea to continue with adding appropriate live music. Also suggested a movie night (hanging a screen and using a projector and audio) only challenge would be the event would have to occur after dark. Mr. Fields suggested an open mic night (challenge would be to have residents perform). Stressing that we need to get the “word out” about upcoming events. Ms. Brandt agreed with Bingo, Open Mic and movie nights allowing adults, families, older and younger residents to participate. Suggested a casual baseball and/or soccer league for residents to sign up, play and socialize. Mr. Bassuner took a vote for the events to occur on Thursday’s weekly. Vote:6-0 approved. Ms. Brandt directed a question to Teresa Brommer at the village hall, the possibility of subscribing to a calendar for events. Ms. Brommer will check on the availability and capabilities of a subscription to a calendar. Ms. Brandt mentioned the need for reusable banners “Family Event at Heiden Haus” to advertise the weekly event. Ms. Hurley sent chat to committee, “I think we need to understand what Village Board has to approve and when as we plan the events”. Ms. Hurley mentioned in closing maybe a village talent show with Ms. Brandt stating that flashlight tag is always popular.
- d. **Blackhawk Country Club, cross country ski trails 2022/2023** – Peter Wickman not present to update. Santhia Brandt noted that Peter Wickman stated at this time there is no update.

- e. **Village Survey** – Mr. Bassuner noted the survey was included in the meeting packet and will be available late in the year to early 2023.
 - f. **Recreation committee members** – Mr. Bassuner suggested committee members seek out new recruits for the Recreation Committee. If members need a break from serving or are unable to attend the meeting to contact him to discuss options and keep him in the loop.
 - g. **Future meeting agenda items** – Mr. Bassuner reiterated, due to new committee members, that agenda items need to be submitted to administration by 1:00 pm the Thursday the week before the scheduled meeting and only items on the agenda can be discussed at the meeting.
