## Employment Opportunities

### DEPUTY CLERK-TREASURER

The Village is hiring for the newly created position of Deputy Clerk-Treasurer. The Deputy Clerk-Treasurer assists with the general duties of the Clerk-Treasurer and those associated with the Village Hall Administrative Office. Examples of duties include assisting with accounts payable, preparing and compiling information necessary for the annual audit, assisting with elections, acting as recording secretary for assigned committees, handling utility billing, and assisting with the required financial reports such as IRS and State of Wisconsin Retirement.

Requirements include an Associate's Degree in Accounting, Finance, or related field and/or public accounting work experience with a minimum of two (2) years of municipal accounting or five (5) years general accounting experience preferred. Must be bondable according to State Statutes and able to obtain a notary public certification. Certification from the WMCA or the MTAW is desirable and will be considered favorably during the hiring process; certification from at least one is expected within four years of hire. Evening work will be required. Experience with Civic Systems and certification in WisVote is a plus. Annual salary range is \$46,675 - \$66,185 DOQ.

### VILLAGE FORESTER

The Forester/Horticulturist is responsible for managing the community forests, parks, public gardens, and other green space. The position performs administrative and technical work and is responsible for regulating, overseeing, and conducting the planting, removal, maintenance, and protection of trees, shrubs, and other plants in or upon all public areas of the Village. The Village established this position because it recognized the value of trees and their significance as an environmental, economic, and community asset.

Requirements include a Bachelor's Degree in Urban Forestry or related field from an accredited college and three years of technical work experience directly related to urban forestry and horticulture/landscaping. Supervisory experience is preferred but not required. Certification by the International Society of Arboriculture as a Certified Arborist is strongly preferred and will be considered favorably during the hiring process. This position requires the ability to work independently and the skills to work well with the general public and other community partners. Some evening and weekend work is required. This is an hourly, non-exempt position and the starting wage rate will be \$23.56-\$30.30 DOQ.

### PUBLIC WORKS CREW

The Public Works Crewmember is a multi-faceted position with tasks involving street, water, wastewater, and stormwater maintenance and repairs, snow plowing, tree-cutting, brush and leaf pick up, and janitorial work, and involves the operation of small and large equipment.

Requirements for this position include a high school diploma or equivalent. Previous experience is strongly

preferred but is not required. Experience with tool/machine maintenance and/or a mechanical background is strongly preferred. Applicants must have a valid Wisconsin CDL or have the ability to obtain one within six months of hire. This position requires the ability to maneuver in various strenuous environments and to operate in extreme weather conditions as well as the ability to lift heavy objects repetitively over an extended period of time. Evening, weekend, and holiday work is required. This position is considered an emergency response position and, as such, the employee is required to live within a 30-minute response time.

This is a full-time, hourly, non-exempt position. The hourly rate for this position will be \$20.40-\$28.08 DOQ. ## VILLAGE CAUCUS RESULTS

The annual Caucus was held virtually before the January 18, 2022 Board meeting to nominate candidates for Trustee and Municipal Judge for the Spring Election.

Three Trustees have terms that expire in April. The nominees for Trustee (in order of nomination) were incumbent Dietmar Bassuner (1102 Shorewood Blvd), Sage Weil (3524 Blackhawk Dr), incumbent John Imes (1008 Edgehill Dr), and Carol Barford (1212 Wellesley Rd). The Municipal Judge's term will also expire this spring. Incumbent Judge Felice Borisy-Rudin was the only person nominated for Municipal Judge.

Each candidate was given an opportunity to address the audience. All will be asked to provide a candidate's statement for the March issue of the Village Bulletin.

## TOWN HALL / CANDIDATE'S FORUM

The Village will hold a virtual Town Hall / Candidate's Forum on March 23 from 6:30-8:00 pm. There are four candidates for three Trustee seats and one candidate for the position of Municipal Judge. ### SHOREWOOD HILLS YOUTH BASKETBALL PROGRAM - SPRING 2022

The Shorewood Hills Youth Basketball Program is adding a spring session in 2022! The program is open to Shorewood Hills Elementary School students and Village residents in grade levels 1 through 6. The program will teach the fundamental rules and skills of basketball in a safe, fun, encouraging, and inclusive learning environment. Participants will build skills, strength, and confidence while learning the importance of good sportsmanship, physical fitness, and teamwork. No previous basketball experience is needed.

The Spring 2022 session will last 6 weeks, starting on April 11, 2022 and running through the week of May 16, 2022. Each class will meet once per week after school at the Shorewood Hills Elementary School outdoor basketball courts, which are located on the south side of the school.

## **DODGEBALL CAMP 2022**

***Registrations Due: Friday, April 1 (to escape the registration late fee!)***

We're holding Dodgeball camp again this year for kids who will be starting 7th and 8th grade in the fall. It's called "Dodgeball Camp", because there will be plenty of that, but also there will be lots of other outdoor activities for the age group: Frisbee golf, soccer tag, ultimate, freeze-tag, rocket making and more. We're only limited by the imagination of the counselors/kids and the physical constraints of the Heiden Haus field. The plan is for camp to run one hour from 3:15-4:15 pm, immediately after Land Rec on the Heiden Haus field on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.

All Shorewood Hills residents and Velma Hamilton Middle School students going into 7th & 8th grade this fall are eligible to enroll. ## **FOUR CORNERS CAMP 2022**

Four Corners Camp is an eight-week outdoor recreation program held at Four Corners Park from 9:30 am to 12:25 pm\*, Monday through Friday for Village children ages 4 to 6 years and who have not yet entered first grade. Camp activities include outdoor play, arts and crafts, music, games, field trips, and a one-night campout for six-year-olds at the end of the program.

*\*On days when there are no swim lessons, pick-up is at 12:00 noon at Four Corners Park.*

Swimming lessons at Shorewood Hills Pool are provided in conjunction with the Pool's morning swim lesson program; on swim days, campers walk with the staff to the Pool from Four Corners Park. During inclement weather, camp is held in the Community Center.

Campers may register for one or both camp sessions (First Session: June 13-July 8; Second Session: July 11-August 5). ## **NIXLE<sup>®</sup> Alerts**

It is similar to systems used on college campuses to notify people of weather or other dangers. We no longer send out notices from Staff's regular email accounts.

Nixle<sup>®</sup> Alerts is a self subscribed system. If you haven't already done so, you can sign up for text alerts by simply texting VOSH to 888777; or you can register for alerts at the Nixle website (<https://local.nixle.com/register/>); or you can use the Widget on the Village's website ([www.shorewood-hills.org/notifications](http://www.shorewood-hills.org/notifications)) to sign up. Each option will get you connected to the Village's periodic notices and keep you informed of the happenings in the Village.
