1. CONTRACT

2. SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS AT BOATHOUSE

A. Everyone was very opposed to cameras at the boathouse. As a committee we felt that the reasons stated for the cameras by police was greatly exaggerated. We felt that cameras are an outrageous invasion of privacy. We are concerned about who looks at the film and what response. Is this just another excuse to profile? How far does it go? Who makes decisions? Will anyone actually have the time to even look at the film? And in the end we really have had no trouble at the boathouse. It is just kids being kids. We suggest that maybe the police actually check the boathouse after 10 and ask the kids to leave if there are problems. Certainly this makes more sense than 24/7 cameras that go 12 months a year when activity is 3 months at the most. Also we are concerned that ultimately we may be asked to pay for something that is unwanted and unnecessary. Our objective is to keep the boathouse quiet and safe at night. Safety and quiet have always been our objectives and in this area we support neighbors who are requesting quiet nights.
