

VILLAGE OF SHOREWOOD HILLS
Public Health & Safety Committee Minutes - DRAFT

Date and Time: Tuesday, April 23, 2024 - 7:00pm

Location: Virtual via Zoom

1. **Call to Order:** Chair Bob Falk called the meeting to order at 7:09pm.
2. **Roll call:** Committee members present were Nadeem Afghan, Bob Falk, Bill Muehl (via speakerphone, then joined via Zoom at 7:28pm), Jim Rogers, and Robb Stankey. Jeremy Tunis was absent-excused and Shabnam Lotfi was absent-excused. Also present were Carol Barford, Interim Administrator Karl Frantz and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Chrissy Kahl.
3. **Note compliance with open meeting law:** Kahl confirmed that the meeting was properly posted.
4. **Approve meeting minutes from March 26, 2024: Rogers moved, seconded by Stankey to approve the March 26, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion carried.**
5. **Public Comments-**This is an opportunity for community members to speak to the Committee. No discussion or action may take place at this time and speakers may be limited to three minutes. No one from the public attended the meeting.
6. **Discussion and possible action of Shorewood Hills Police Department vehicular pursuit policy:** Former Chair, Barford, gave background information on this item which included the work the PHS committee has done on this item and the draft letter created in response to the letter sent by Mayor Rhodes-Conway. **Rogers moved, seconded by Afghan to recommend the response letter to the Mayor for the pursuit policy to the Village Board with all further edits as the Chair of the committee may determine. Motion carried.**

Meeting recess at 7:26pm due to the recording secretary computer issues. Meeting back from recess at 7:28pm.

Barford left the meeting at 7:46pm

7. **Discussion and possible action on proposed parking ordinance changes near Shorewood Hills Elementary School:** Stankey gave an overview of this item. Through a village ordinance we can use parking cutouts for temporary parking during school hours. Discussion included: ordinance needed for child safety at the school during drop off/pick up; draft ordinance to be drawn by the attorney; suggestions for what should be in the ordinance; **Stankey moved, seconded by Muehl to recommend to the Village Board a change to the ordinance to allow for parking on the school side of Shorewood Boulevard in the parking cutouts during school hours and to have a draft created by the Village Attorney. Motion carried.**

- 8. Discussion of police and staff recognition:** Falk gave some background information. Discussion included: giving positive recognition to police to improve morale and retention; question-of-the month by Chief Pharo for the bulletin; resident ride a long with an officer; interview an officer and put in the bulletin; highlight police events; address police pay and incentive program.
- 9. Discussion of Drive 20 Challenge:** Falk gave an overview of this program. Discussion included: intent is for safer streets; focus on larger safe streets initiatives; engage residents at a low cost; this is a positive piece of public safety and keeps the committee visible.
- 10. Future Agenda Items** – This is an opportunity for committee members to request an item be added to a future agenda. No discussion may take place on any requested items at this time and committee members should not make lengthy statements on their request.
 - a. Continuous fire, EMS and police calls monthly
 - b. Finding, hiring, training and retaining police officers as ways to support the police
 - c. Public education events in the future

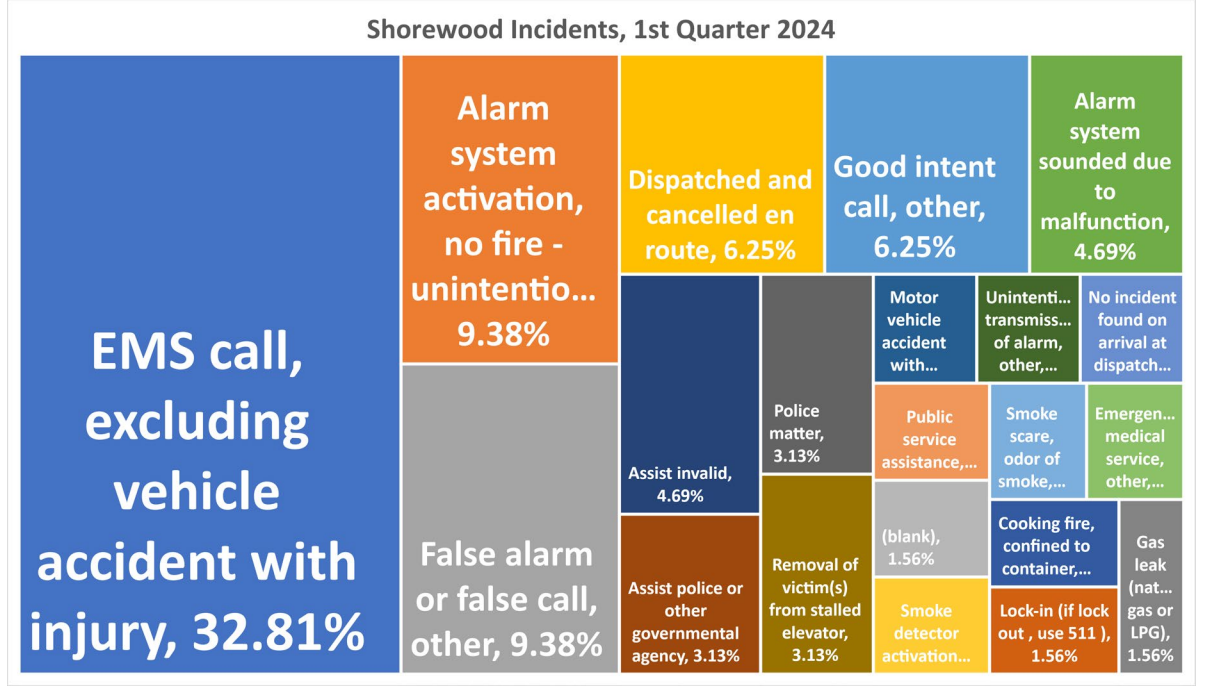
Drive 20 Challenge

As I am sure everyone knows, we have a problem with speeding in the Village. It is not uncommon to see cars whiz past at 30mph, 40mph, and sometimes higher speeds, especially on a long stretch of road, such as Shorewood Blvd or Lake Mendota Drive. Obviously, this is a safety issue, especially with so many people using our streets to bike and walk.

As I learned when I was an undergraduate in Traffic Engineering (a long time ago I admit, but I don't think the basic principles have changed much), there are two ways to slow traffic. The first are physical deterrents such as speed bumps, lane narrowing, lane geometry, garden triangles, etc. and the second is changing driver behavior. While we have tried many of the physical deterrents with varying success, I am wondering if we might make more of an effort to change driver behavior, at least with our residents.

I have made a commitment to myself to never drive over 20mph in the Village. I notice that in many cases I end up with cars behind me forced to drive the same speed. While one person driving 20 mph may not have a big effect on slowing traffic, perhaps a committed group of residents doing the same would. Is there a way we could mobilize our residents who are concerned about speed to commit to a "Drive 20" challenge? This may be a no cost collective way to slow the overall traffic in the Village.

On 4/13/24 at 11:43pm, SHPD officers responded to the Meriter Hospital Emergency Room to assist Dane County Sheriff's deputies with a forcible blood draw from an OWI arrest. That suspect fought with law enforcement, but no one was injured. SHPD officers responded because they were the closest officers available.

On 4/14/24 at 3:18pm, an SHPD officer assisted VA Police by looking for, and finding a subject having a mental health crisis that left the VA Hospital Emergency Room. Officers transported the subject back to the VA Hospital.

On 4/17/24 7:48am, an SHPD officer responded with UWPD for a woman attacking people in a bus stop on Highland Ave. The woman was located nearby and arrested for Disorderly Conduct.

On 4/18/24 at 11:00am, an SHPD officer responded to a restaurant in the Village for a complaint about a person that was previously arrested during a disturbance loitering inside but had since left. The SHPD officer found that the suspect was court-ordered to not be at that location. The officer forwarded Bail Jumping charges to the District Attorney's Office.

On 4/19/24 at 11:17am, an SHPD officer located a vehicle on Old Middleton Rd. that had been reported as driving all over the road. The driver was found to be having a medical emergency, and EMS responded.

On 4/29/24 at 7:25pm, SHPD officers responded to assist UWPD and Madison Fire with a pulse-less, non-breathing patient at Picnic Point.

Training

Lt. Weitzel and Det. Dostalek attended death investigation training.

Det. Dostalek attended the WI Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force training conference.

Staffing

We had two potential candidates for the open police officer positions. Both were screened out of the hiring process. We are continuing to accept applications.

PO Ted Schwarz (full-time) submitted his notice of resignation. His last day with the SHPD is 5/2/24.

PO Jamison Hoff (full-time) submitted his notice of resignation. His last day with the SHPD is 5/12/24.

Former SHPD PO Harun Gurel (full-time) has been rehired. His first day back will be 5/5/24. He will be reassigned to the 3pm – 11pm patrol shift.

So, here's where we currently stand: We are down two full-time officers. Harun basically got his spot back and we need to hire to replace Ted and Jamison.

Vehicles

The 2021 marked squad car that was damaged in the crash noted in the March report has been "totaled" by the insurance company and we have received the payout. We will be using the recently purchased 2023 to replace that car. Unfortunately, our upfitter is booked out until June, so there is a delay in getting that car in service. Meanwhile, we are using the 2017 as our primary marked squad car. The dealer that found the 2023 was able to find a 2024 model in another state that they are having delivered to their dealership for us. Once the 2023 is up and running, we will have the 2024 upfitted and the 2017 decommissioned.

Employee Recognition / Compliments / Complaints:

Det. Dostalek: A University of Wisconsin staff member requested assistance from SHPD to check the welfare of a student that made suicidal statements. That student lives in the Village. Det. Dostalek worked with the Madison Fire CARES Team in attempts to contact the student, and having determined that there were exigent circumstances, entered the residence of the student. The student was not there. Det.

Dostalek requested an emergency "ping" of the student's cell phone and learned her location. Ultimately, the student was located out of state at her parent's home. The original caller told me that she was very impressed with how Det. Dostalek handled the situation and took it seriously. She was thankful for Det. Dostalek's follow-through in checking the apartment and pinging the cell phone to find the student. The student was offered services and CARES planned to follow-up.

You probably noticed references to the Madison Fire Department CARES Team in the SHPD monthly reports lately. Because the Village of Shorewood Hills contracts with Madison Fire for Fire and EMS service, we benefit from all their resources, including the CARES Team.

Community Alternative Response Emergency Services (CARES) is designed to serve as an additional available resource for behavioral health emergencies that occur in our community. A cornerstone of the initiative is to ensure that medical and behavioral healthcare is integrated at the onset of crisis intervention, increasing patient satisfaction while diverting people away from emergency rooms and jails.

Modeled after successful patient-centered programs like STAR in Denver, Colorado and CAHOOTS in Eugene, Oregon, CARES consists of three response teams comprised of one Madison Fire Department community paramedic and one Journey Mental Health Center crisis worker.

These teams are trained and equipped to respond to non-violent behavioral health emergency calls that do not require law enforcement. Their training curriculum includes 40-hour crisis intervention training, cultural competency training, de-escalation training, suicide prevention and risk assessment, trauma-informed care, and more, exceeding the standard in behavioral health training for paramedics. Journey Mental Health crisis workers have been trained on dispatch radio protocol and 911 response, as well as other Madison Fire Department policies and operating procedures.

In addition to responding to 911 calls, the CARES teams spend considerable time building relationships throughout the community at local resource centers, shelters, and mental health care facilities. Between active calls for service, the teams follow up with patients to ensure they have been connected with the services they need.

Since the program's inception on September 1, 2021, CARES has responded to approximately 5000 calls for service. CARES Teams are on duty from 8:00am to 8:00pm on weekdays, and on weekends from 10:00am to 8:00pm. Dane County recently implemented a grant funding program for other municipalities in the Madison area, so the program will expand further.

Police Recognition

At our last Board meeting (April 16, 2024), the Administrator highlighted that our police force is having trouble with retention. In addition, morale among the force is slipping. I quote from her memo to the Board:

“We have continued to have significant turnover in the department and those who have left have done so primarily because they can get significantly more pay elsewhere. There is also sentiment among the department that they are not valued or respected by the Board and the community with how things have been, especially over the last two years, with baseless accusations going unchecked, repeated calls for contracting the police service out, and statements that the PD isn’t doing its job simply because some individuals do not like the decisions the officers are making. Combine that with the major pay differentials and we have a department that is close to falling apart”.

While the pay issue is being addressed (the Board passed a measure to provide retention incentives as well as new hire incentives), I believe we must do more to recognize our police force in a positive light and highlight the value they bring to our community. I would like to ask the committee to come up with ideas on how we might do this. Here are a couple of ideas to help prime the pump.

- Village Bulletin profile of officers
 - Highlight an officer every month?
- Summary reports of police statistics
 - Indicate how much the officers are doing on a day-to-day basis
 - Highlight significant events
- Police Appreciation Day (or perhaps a broader Staff Recognition Day?)
 - BBQ/potluck event?
 - In cooperation with the Village League/Recognition Committee?
