

MGE Electric Upgrade: Project Update



Madison Gas and Electric (MGE) has been making progress upgrading the electric system in the Village of Shorewood Hills to enhance service reliability, reduce outages, minimize tree trimming, and to prepare the area for the next generation of power delivery.

This work includes replacing aging facilities and installing some new underground electric lines throughout the Village, as well as replacing or removing existing overhead power lines.

What's new

The project is currently at 80 percent completion rate, and construction activities are ongoing. The work is expected to be completed in the fall of 2025.



MGE and its digging contractor, Meade, are installing new electric lines in and around these remaining areas within the village:

- Edgehill Drive and Shorewood Boulevard.
- Tally Ho Lane and Topping Road.
- The area between Dartmouth Road and University Bay Drive.

The crews will then turn their attention to residential areas in the village, including those where residents have signed easements so we may remove the existing overhead lines in their front or back yards.

After construction, our crews will promptly restore any disturbed areas to their pre-existing state. You also may see Hooper crews trimming trees for lines that will be rebuilt overhead to accommodate taller poles.

Easement requests

Thank you to those residents who have signed easements, allowing this upgrade to move forward. The need for an easement is dependent on the location of the property and how it may be impacted by the project.
