

PUBLIC SECTOR ASSISTANCE AND INSURANCE

FEMA Federal Disaster Declaration

If a Federal Disaster Declaration is made, the Village may be reimbursed for a number of expenses related to the flood (not covered by insurance). Documentation is key to how much FEMA would allocate to each individual community.

Wisconsin Disaster Fund (WDF)

The Village may qualify for this State-funded program that reimburses local units of government for debris clearance, protective measures, and road/bridge repair. Not available to individuals.

Municipal Property Insurance Company (MPIC)

The Wisconsin League of Municipalities insurance program has been responsive to our claims of damage.

- Damaged police squad – Repaired for \$2,363.58. Insurance paid \$2,047.
- Village Hall – Carpet, drywall damage, dehumidifying. Insurance covering minus deductible.
- DPW Building – Minor water in lower level. Insurance covering dehumidifying costs minus deductible.
- Pool Facility – Basement electrical, cleanup, other areas to be determined. Insurance probably covering all costs.
- Stormwater Facilities (McKenna, Bigfoot, Marina) – May be covered by insurance, may be eligible for State or Federal disaster relief.
- Roadways (Marina, McKenna, Rustic Bridge) – May be covered by insurance, may be eligible for State or Federal disaster relief.
