Thanking Courtland Martens for his Service to the Village*

WHEREAS; Lt. Martens was hired as a part-time officer in early 2000 and was promoted to a full-time position with the SHPD in August of 2000.

WHEREAS; During his tenure with the Village of Shorewood Hills, Lt. Martens served in the role of a training officer and trained over 30 full-time and part-time members of the department.

WHEREAS; Lt. Martens was extremely active as a patrol officer and arrested over 750 intoxicated drivers in his career. He was also a Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Instructor and trained other officers to properly administer the SFST battery to suspected drunk drivers and was also trained in the detection of drugged drivers and made the highways in Shorewood Hills and Dane County safer for the motoring public.

WHEREAS; Lt. Martens cared for the community and worked to ensure those suffering from mental health crisis were treated with dignity and respect.

WHEREAS; Lt Martens efforts, experience, and knowledge helped shape the SHPD into the organization it is today and he will be missed.
